Covid Safety in Church

Thank you for all that you are doing to keep each other as safe as possible. In revising our risk assessments to coincide with going into Alert Level Zero, we are required to urge you to:

- 1) Think about being doubly vaccinated if you have not been already. This is one of the best things we can do to help each other keep free from serious illness.
- 2) Take lateral flow tests. In our risk assessment it states clergy and volunteers are strongly encouraged to do this, but all congregation members may benefit. Tests may be obtained free online or at Chirk chemist or any other pharmacy.
